## Leaders Blessed In Nicaragua

Nearly 800 pastors and leaders gathered this last fall in the cities of Leon and Managua, Nicaragua for "life coaching, evangelism, and discipleship" training. Led by Pastor Daniel Prieto and his team, the focus was on both healing hurting leaders and then challenging them to "spread out during 2012 Jesus' word in their neighborhoods to evangelize and disciple a minimum of 3,000 new believers."

Missions Press provided 2 crates full of 300,000 various tracts and 12,000 small group guides, all written by Pastor Prieto. Mauricio Rodriguez, co-author of his riveting story "The Gift of Heaven," joined the team and shared his testimony with many. He also passed out his booklet in the town of Esteli, where the story is based.

## Press Opens Doors To India, Pakistan

Foursquare leaders in India and Pakistan were blessed to receive training and materials from a Children's Gospel Box short-term team this last fall. Connecting with the National Leaders of each country, leaders Dave and Joy McInnis developed what is expected to be a long-term relationship between Missions Press, India, and Pakistan.

According to the McInnises, each nation has strong leaders but "lack financial resources and Gospel tools." In Pakistan, even under strict Islamic law, the Foursquare Church is bold and growing. Training and resourcing some 40 leaders was critical for a nation where 35% of the population is 14 years or younger. The leader of the Foursquare Church in Pakistan is connected with many other evangelistic churches and our hope is to eventually supply them all with free Gospel resources.

In India, the team ministered in urban and rural

### Christmas Comes To Cambodia

Two of the most effective pieces of evangelistic literature in all of Cambodia are FMP's famous "God" booklet and the "Christmas Tract," which describes the meaning of Christmas to this predominately Buddhist nation.

Both have won tens of thousands to the Lord and have contributed greatly to the amazing growth of the Foursquare Church in Cambodia. Last year, funds provided over 100,000 of these tracts, and the Press funded the printing of some 1,600 Illustrated Bibles. According to missionary Ted Olbrich, this Bible is key to both winning the lost and discipling new and older believers. Once given to an individual, it is passed on to the entire family and extended family.

### Philippines Reaching the Next Generation

Led by Pastor Matthew Agosto and Rev. Fred Horner this past fall, the C-G Box team to the Philippines trained intensively five national children's leaders to be full-time C-G Box representatives. These individuals are working in concert with the Foursquare Church in the Philippines to reach this entire nation that is made up of over 1,700 islands.

In the last quarter of 2011 alone, C-G Box rallies accounted for over 2,000 decisions for Christ!

## Why We Need Your Prayers!

The following testimony reminds us all that the ministry of Missions Press must be constantly undergirded in prayer...

*"A crate shipment full of Children's Gospel Box material was sent to Bolivia in time for a large children's crusade, as well as for C-G Box training which would ultimately lead to tens of thousands of children being witnessed to. FMP Latin America Coordinator Sheila Ransford traveled to Bolivia to be part of the crusade and to lead the training. Once there, she informed us that the shipment was stuck in customs. But it was not just our crate, we were told—NO shipments were getting through because a government dispute had closed down the entire shipping area. Countless shipments were stuck behind chained gates. FMP has a weekly prayer time, and we prayed for this situation. At the end of the prayer session, FMP Illustrator and Shipping Coordinator Eric Jansen felt led to pray one more time for the Bolivia shipment. He prayed that God would arrange for just the right person to show up at just the right time—perhaps a fellow Christian in the Bolivian customs department—and that he would hear our case and be moved to open the gates just long enough to release our crate in time for the C-G Box training session. Well, that's exactly what happened! We don't know if the official was a fellow Christian, but the gates were opened just long enough—for just a half hour!—the same time that our Foursquare representative was there to try to get the crate out! God pulled everything together at just the right time, with a very small window of opportunity, and just in time for the training."*

### Fruit From C-G Box In Honduras Continues

Children's evangelism and discipleship continue to impact thousands in San Pedro Sula through the largest Foursquare church in the world. Last year, in four children's leader seminars, 155 children's leaders were trained and given C-G Boxes. Please pray, as much more must be done to reach the children.
